# BRINGING BACK THE CIF

As the result of the increasing costs of maintenance on our campus, we are bringing back the Capital Improvements Fund in 2023.

Huff's is facing major expenses in the coming years. The church roof is in poor condition and will need to be replaced soon. The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection is forcing Huff's to install water treatment systems in the church, the chapel, and the park. The wood on the buildings needs to be painted and, in some places, replaced. Without additional donations, these expenses will have to be taken out of our investments.

Union Council hopes that by bringing these upcoming expenses to your attention, we can reduce the need to withdraw invested money, the income from which is being used to supplement the operating expenses of the church.
