MEMBERSHIP ROLL REVIEW

Chapter 8 of the new Constitution and Bylaws approved by this Congregation in 2022 requires the Membership Rolls be reviewed annually. Following is a brief description of the Membership categories of Huff's Union Church:

- Active (Voting) Membership includes Confirmed members who have either Communion or a contribution on record with Huff's Union Church during the previous 24 months. (Communion or contributions at other churches are not recorded by Huff's Church.) Only Active members have both voice and vote at Congregation Meetings and other benefits as determined by Church Council.
- Associate (Non-Voting) Membership includes Confirmed members who do not have either Communion or a contribution on record with Huff's Church during the previous 24 months (or a member whose contact information or whereabouts is unknown for the previous 12 months) may be moved with Church Council approval to the Associate Membership Roll. Associate members have no vote at Congregation meetings, do not regularly receive printed newsletters, and have increased donations/costs for use of facilities, cemetery lots, and services such as weddings and funerals, etc. as determined by Church Council. Associate members desiring to request reinstatement to Active Membership shall consult with the Pastor.
- Friend of this Congregation is an individual who has been on the Associate Membership roll with no Communion or contribution on record with Huff's Church for at least 36 months or if contact information is unknown for 24 months may be removed with Church Council approval from the Membership Roll of this Congregation and documented as a Friend of this Congregation. Requests to become an active member are made to the Pastor.

Church Council may authorize exceptions to a change in membership status due to an individual's extenuating circumstances.
