### PASTOR'S ARTICLE

# What Pastor John is reading this month:

The focus of my reading this month has been on Volunteer Motivation. Specifically, I have been learning more about Self-Determination Theory (SDT). SDT is a theory of motivation. It holds that all of us have three key psychological needs: autonomy, competence, and relatedness.

Autonomy is the sense that one has choice and willingly endorses one's behavior. Competence is the experience of mastery and being effective in one's activity. Relatedness is the need to feel connected and a sense of belonging with others. Theologically these are free will (autonomy), gifts (competence), and community (relatedness).

SDT helps us understand the importance of connecting people to their God-given gifts and passion for ministry. It underscores strong volunteer member involvement and helps us see why empowering discipleship through service is critical for involving youth and young adults in the church.
