In the event that the business of the meeting cannot be completed for any reason including but not limited to inclement weather, provision of additional information, or lack of quorum, the meeting will be continued to Sunday, April 13, 2025, within the 10:30 a.m. worship service. Those Active Members who attend the meeting on April 13 shall constitute a quorum and are authorized to act on these matters even if less than 50 are in attendance. If the voting is done on April 6, then the April 13 meeting will not be held.
