If you are new to Huff's Church, or want to bring a friend, this is a great way to get to know our folks while they work on one of our big fund-raising projects.

## PASTOR'S ARTICLE CELEBRATIONS

We always celebrate **World Communion Sunday** on the first Sunday of October. World Communion Sunday was first started at Shadyside Presbyterian Church in Pittsburgh, PA back in 1933, by their pastor the Reverend Dr. Hugh Thomson Kerr. It started to catch on with other churches around 1940 and the following years. It was started as a way to remember our connection with people around the world.

Setting aside one Sunday a year to recognize the wider body of Christ is a way of reminding ourselves of this connection and to remember that the Body of Christ is much larger than the four walls of our church. With all the divisiveness that is happening in the world right now, it is good to take a day and celebrate our connection with others.

It can also be something that we celebrate each time we commune together in church and each time we break bread around the table at home. We remember that we are part of something much larger than ourselves, and that we are part of the sacred work of God creating a new covenant in our midst.

This year we are also celebrating **Harvest Sunday** on October 3rd. We have moved it to this date for convenience, as all our donations of fresh produce will be shared that week when the Friends, Inc. Food for the Needy truck comes to our parking lot. So, plan on bringing in the bounty from your Fall gardens as well as donating any packaged food that you want to share that Sunday.

I invite you to also think about what else you are harvesting in your life right now. What else can you share with others, beyond food or material items? What can you give of your time? Your knowledge? Your experience? Your love?

Let us remember that we have been blessed by God **so that** we can be a blessing to others. We give out of our bounty, so that others might have enough each day. What and how can we give so that they have enough and more?

## **REVIEW PROPOSED NEW HUFFS UNION CHURCH INC CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS**

Since 2011 we have lived in shared ministry at Huff's Church but legally there are still 3 separate corporations of Huff's UCC, Huff's ELCA and Huff's Union. Several neighboring Union churches including St Peters and Maxatawny have gone through the legal process to merge into one "federated" corporation. In August 2019 the ELCA and UCC agreed with other denominations involved in shared ministry to use the term "union" instead of "federated" for congregations like Huff's where all members are both ELCA and UCC.

The first step to legally merge Huff's ELCA and Huff's UCC corporations into one remaining Huff's Union Church Corporation is to develop a new Constitution and Bylaws for Huff's Union Church. After much prayerful consideration, a complete proposal has been developed for the new Constitution and Bylaws for Huff's Union Church.

**To save paper, we will have a *New Constitution* link on the Huff's Church website [www.huffschurch.com](http://www.huffschurch.com) so those who have internet access will be able to see the proposal there. Some paper copies will be available at the Church and if there are no markings on these copies, we ask that they be returned for others to review.**

**On Sundays, October 10th and October 17th, from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. there will be an informal gathering both in-person and by zoom to answer any questions you have on the proposal.** Zoom links will be provided in the eblast or you may contact the Church office to have the link emailed to you.

There likely will be further changes and clarifications recommended by church members, Council, legal advisor, Synod and Conference. When all input is gathered and revisions made, a final proposal of the entire Union constitution will be approved by the Church Council to be presented to the Congregation for review and final congregational vote.
