PASTOR'S ARTICLE: BUILDING CONNECTIONS, BUILDING TRUST

Building connections with people in the church is one of the most critical tasks of a pastor. As a pastor gets to know people better, and as people get to know their pastor better, trust is built. Everything that a local church does is built on a foundation of trust that is guided by the Holy Spirit.

Over the course of the next several months, I would like to find ways to better connect with the people at Huff's Church. I am asking for your help in making this happen.

Instead of saying, "this is how we will do this," I want to invite you to help me co-create how we might go about doing this together. This is a "We" project, not a "Me" project.

To get us started, I would like to share some ideas for people to think and pray about. I'm sure that once you start thinking and praying about this, your ideas will make this even better. So here are some of my initial ideas:

- Hold a monthly "pastor's meet and greet" immediately after worship. Keep it short 45 minutes so people can then go to lunch.
- Create a pastor-parish team to build connections with our older members.
- Create a pastor-parish team to build connections with families, especially families with children at home.
- Employ transitional ministry processes to build stronger connections and relationships.
- How about going over the above list and sharing. Yes, this idea works. Also, which of these ideas might best be retired. (Remember this is a We, not Me, process.)

ANNOUNCEMENT OF CONGREGATION MEETING
